\$133.00 for Election Day, plus \$20.00 for training class plus mileage
** (Supplies must be picked up before the Election and returned Election night)

Clerks-

\$118.00 for Election Day, plus \$20.00 for training class

PollWorkers Needed

Duties of Inspector:

- ✓ Attend Training Class(es).
- ✓ Check your Polling Place **before** Election Day and arrange for entry **by** 6:00 a.m. on Election Day.
- ✓ Verify **ALL** supplies are correct **BEFORE** Election Day.
- ✓ Contact the Election Clerks on your Precinct Board to remind them when and where to show up on Election Day.
- ✓ Assign tasks and arrange breaks and meal times.
- ✓ Supervise Election Clerks and enforce Election Codes.
- ✓ You must return ICE Cartridges, ballots and required supplies back to the specified receiving area Election Night with an Election Clerk assigned by you.
- ✓ You may recommend Election Clerks that you would like to work with.

Unemployment Code

“Employment” does not include service performed in any of the following:
634.5 (7) (A) Except as otherwise provided in subparagraph (B), an election official or election worker if the amount of remuneration reasonably expected to be received by the individual during the calendar year for services as an election official or election worker is less than one thousand dollars (\$1,000).

PollWorkers Needed

Duties of a Clerk:

- ✓ Attend Training Class(es).
- ✓ Arrive at your assigned Polling Place **by** 6:00 a.m. on Election Day.
- ✓ Perform duties assigned by the Inspector and/or Supervisor.
- ✓ Stay at the polling place after the polls close and assist with closing procedures.
- ✓ An assigned Election Clerk will accompany the Inspector or Supervisor to the specified receiving area Election Night with ICE Cartridges, and specific supplies.
- ✓ You can assist bilingual voters if you speak a language in addition to English.
