#### Violation Description:

Exhaust hoods shall be provided to remove toxic gases, heat, grease, vapors and smoke and be approved by the local building department. Canopy-type hoods shall extend 6' beyond all cooking equipment. All areas shall have sufficient ventilation to facilitate proper food storage. Toilet rooms shall be vented to the outside air by a screened openable window, an air shaft, or a light-switch activated exhaust fan, consistent with local building codes. (114149, 114149.1)

904.11 Commercial cooking systems. Commercial cooking equipment that produces grease laden vapors shall be provided with a Type I hood, in accordance with the California Mechanical Code, and an automatic fire-extinguishing system that is listed and labeled for its intended use as follows:

1. Wet-chemical extinguishing system, complying with UL 300.
2. Carbon dioxide extinguishing systems.
3. Automatic fire sprinkler systems

### Overall Inspection Comments

This facility was allowed a temporary permit to allow necessary modifications including hood vent fire suppression system. A two month extension was given. That has also expired. Failure to complete system within 30 days will result in revocation of the permit to operate.
