Recyclable Items:

Paper and cardboard: newspapers, magazines, telephone books, junk mail and envelopes, corrugated cardboard, office paper, empty soda and beer cases, non-metallic greeting cards, food boxes, etc. No paper products with food residue.

Plastic Bottles: Bottles #1-#7 (No Styrofoam) Rinse or wipe off food residue.

Glass Bottles: Beverage and food bottles, and jars (any color) Rinse or wipe off food residue.

Metal: All food and beverage cans, and clean aluminum foil Rinse or wipe off food residue.

Gable Top and Aseptic Containers: milk and juice cartons, soy milk containers, drink boxes, soap boxes, etc.
